Discussion Guide for Micro Film – Grandma's Present

Purpose:

Upon completion of the discussion, the students should be able to:

- 1. appreciate the core values of honesty and fairness
- 2. understand the importance of respect for others and not to be selfish

Target Groups:

Primary students

Time Allocation:

About 30 minutes

Discussion Guide:

- Watch Part 1 of micro film "Grandma's Present" and discuss the following question:
 - o If Kim accepts Grandma's offer, what would be the possible consequences?
- Continue to watch Part 2 of micro film "Grandma's Present" and discuss the following questions:
 - What is wrong with Kim's act?
 - o In the end, Amy did not accept the little pink sheep doll from the store owner. What are the reasons? Do you agree with her?

Conclusion/Key Messages:

• The principles of fairness include respect for others, abiding by the laws and regulations, equal opportunities, etc. In the film, Kim and Grandma had done something selfish that causing unfairness to others.

<u>Kim</u>

- Kim took advantage of his position by taking away the doll of limited edition. This lowered
 the chance of others for getting the doll and caused unfairness.
- He breached the store owner's trust on him and compromised the values of honesty and fairness.

Grandma

• Grandma requested to buy the doll of limited edition directly because she did not want to disappoint Amy. In a sense, Grandma's act was selfish and not respecting the rules of fair play. No matter how good of her motive is, it is not justifiable. It compromises her personal value and deprives other people's interest. Honesty and fairness are the core values of a fair society.
