Speak up for a Corruption-free Hong Kong Slogan and Icon Design Competition

Theme

To join forces in upholding the core value of integrity and to encourage creativity in the promotion of anticorruption message, the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) organises the "All for Integrity" Speak up for a Corruption-free Hong Kong – Slogan and Icon Design Competition. The Competition aims at engaging participation of the public to convey the "support corruption-free" message with creative slogans and icons.

Entry Category

- Youth Category (aged 25 or below) and Open Category (aged over 25)
- Participants can be an individual or a team of up to four people of the same age category, i.e. Youth category or Open category

Deadline of Submission

15 February 2016 (Postal submission will be dated by postmark. Late submission will not be accepted.)

Submission Specification

Slogan design

• A slogan less than 30 words (excluding punctuation), in either Chinese or English, or in both Chinese and English.

Icon design

- The icon can be presented in the form of drawing or colour printing. There is no restriction on drawing tools.
- The icon can be a symbolic visual design in any form or any human or animal publicity figure.
- Digital copy submitted via email should be in JPEG format with 300 dpi resolution.
- Entries submitted by post or in person must be presented on a piece of A4 (297 mm x 210 mm) plain or drawing paper.



Method of Submission

Prizes

Participants should submit their entries together with the completed entry form in any way as follows:

- In-person submission to any ICAC Regional Office.

- The adjudication panel will select outstanding entries based on the content and creative idea. The awardees will be presented with a certificate of appreciation and an ICAC souvenir.
- The adjudication panel will also shortlist five finalists in each category for online voting at the competition website. The entry with the highest number of online votes will be given the "Award for the most liked slogan for a corruption-free Hong Kong" or the "Award for the most liked icon for a corruption-free Hong Kong".
- The ICAC will consider using the winning entries at the territory-wide publicity programme(s).
- Results will be announced at the competition website in mid-2016. Winners will be notified by letter individually and invited to attend the award ceremony.
