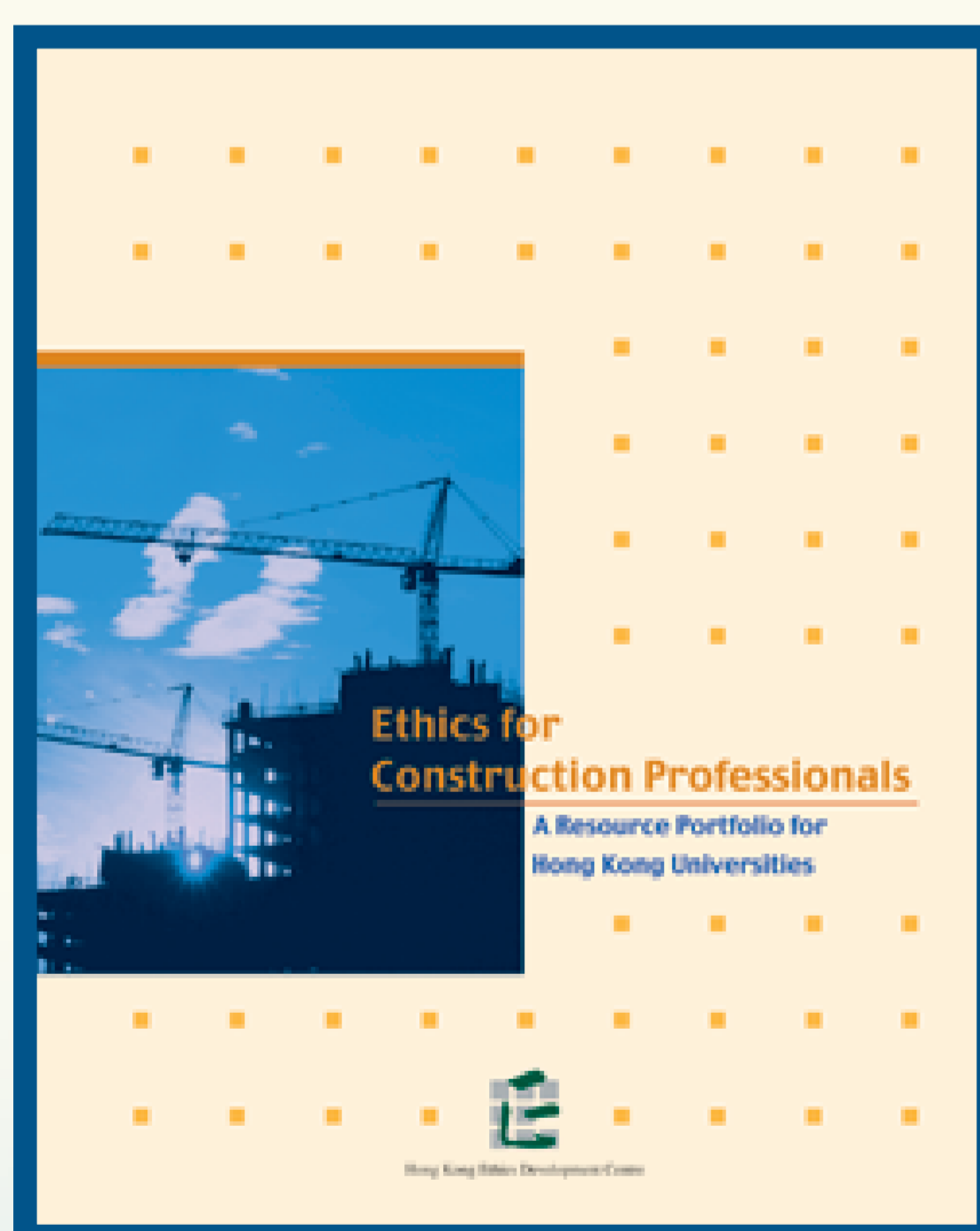


# Fostering Ethical Corporate Culture

## 推廣誠信企業文化

The ICAC advocates good corporate governance as the first line of defence against corruption and the Community Relations Department works closely with regulatory and professional bodies to organise ethics training for company directors, company secretaries, accountants, construction-related professionals and business executives on corruption prevention and ways to practise good corporate governance.

Under the two-year Business Ethics Promotion Programme for listed companies launched in November 2003, the department had contacted a total of 740 listed companies. Among them, 575 (78%) have used or are actively pursuing the use of corruption prevention services to control risks of malpractice e.g. about 500 listed companies have formulated codes of conduct to set ethical standards for compliance by staff.

ICAC reaches at least 1,300 business organisations and 34,000 managers and workers through various efforts of preventive education each year

透過各種防貪教育活動，廉署每年接觸逾一千三百家商業機構和三萬四千名管理人員及前線職員

廉署倡導以良好企業管治作為預防貪污的首度防線，又與各市場監管機構和專業團體緊密合作，為公司董事、公司秘書、會計師、建造業專業人士、行政人員等提供誠信培訓，傳遞防貪和推行良好企業管治的方法。

該處在2003年11月展開一項為期兩年的「上市公司商業道德推廣計劃」，接觸了740家上市公司，當中有575家（佔78%）使用廉署的防貪服務以制定系統與程序，管控舞弊行為，例如當中約500家公司已制定職員紀律守則，訂明專業操守的標準。
