

United Front against Corruption

共建全球反貪陣線

Corruption knows no boundaries. To combat corporate corruption and related crimes, which nowadays are increasingly complex and transnational in nature, the ICAC has established and maintains a close link with overseas anti-corruption and law enforcement agencies as well as its counterparts in Mainland China and Macao. Through reciprocal visits, joint command courses, seminars and international symposiums, mutual legal and case assistance, a united front against corruption has taken shape on a global scale. In the past 5 years, ICAC has successfully extradited 11 fugitives from 5 jurisdictions to face criminal prosecutions in Hong Kong, epitomising the importance of international cooperation in serving the cause of justice.
