

Legislative Council Election

Reminder to Electors

The Elections (Corrupt and Illegal Conduct) Ordinance, enforced by the ICAC, aims to uphold clean and fair elections.

According to this Ordinance, an elector **MUST NOT within Hong Kong or elsewhere:**

- Solicit or accept any advantage (including money, gift, etc.), food, drink or entertainment from any person for not voting at an election, or voting or not voting for a particular candidate or particular candidates;
- Offer any advantage (including money, gift, etc.), food, drink or entertainment to any person as an inducement to or a reward for the latter not to vote at an election, or to vote or not to vote for a particular candidate or particular candidates;
- Use or threaten to use force or duress against any person for inducing the latter to vote or not to vote at an election; or to vote or not to vote for a particular candidate or particular candidates;
- Induce any person by deception not to vote at an election, or to vote or not to vote for a particular candidate or particular candidates;
- Wilfully obstruct or prevent any person from voting at an election;
- Incite another person not to vote or to cast invalid vote at an election by any activity in public during election period;
- Vote at an election knowing that he/she is not entitled to do so; or vote at an election after having knowingly or recklessly given false or misleading information to an electoral officer.
