



Integrity Idol- Recent Impact

- Integrity Idol recently made the Minister of Justice in Mali;
- Integrity Idol recently made the DG of Labor in Nepal;
- Integrity Idol recently selected as part of an 8 man ethics committee in South Africa;
- Coordination with national level processes (such as the Open Government Partnership);
- Continued media coverage of the Idols across all countries.





Integrity Idol- Next Steps

- Continuing to demonstrate the benefits of celebrating good people or "positive deviants";
- Working with the Idols to translate individual integrity into a shift in organizational cultures;
- Scaling the competition through licensing the content and creating large-scale media partnerships;
- Building out the network of Integrity Idols and connecting the Idols to each other, civil service training schools and universities.
