

How young people experience the impacts of corruption




Poor public services

Certain barriers prevent young people from participating in developing and implementing anti-corruption strategies.












































ANNUAL BARANGAY (VILLAGE) BUDGET MANDATED FOR YOUTH

It seeks to raise the standards of youth governance by making best practices the norm in our youth institutions.

Institutionalized Transparency Portals (Online & Offline) for SKs, LYDCs, LYDOs, Youth Organizations









- Amplify calls by youth activists and CSOs re: anti-corruption strategies







