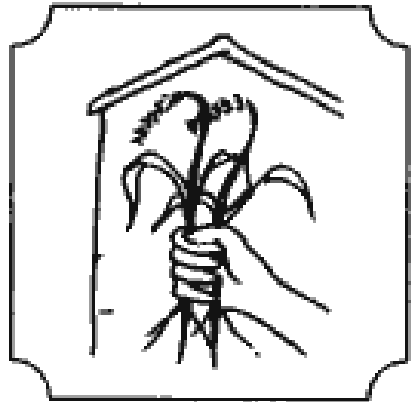



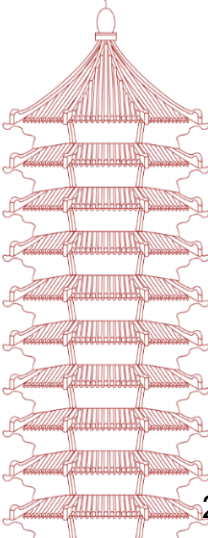

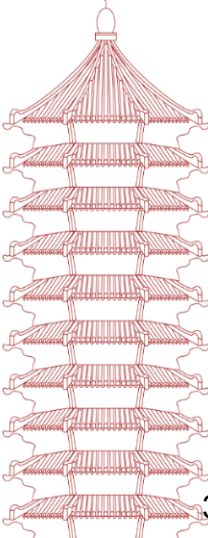


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The concept of integrity is extensive.

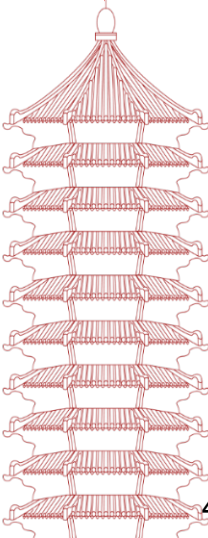
- **For ordinary people:** Honesty and trustworthiness

Why youth integrity education in universities

- **Ideal educational timing**
 - Critical for the formation of worldviews, life philosophies, and values
 - Establishing a concept of integrity during youth ensures a future generation of ethical leaders
- **Conducive campus environment**
 - Blend of school and society
 - Not only textual descriptions, but also practical experience

Faculty members

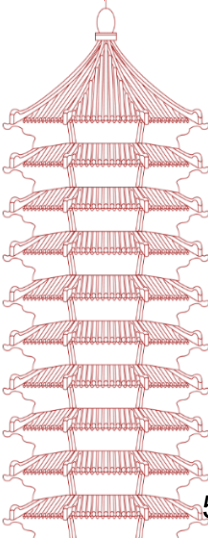
- Interact most frequently and closely with students

- Administrative system manages the school, include the educational and guiding duties towards students

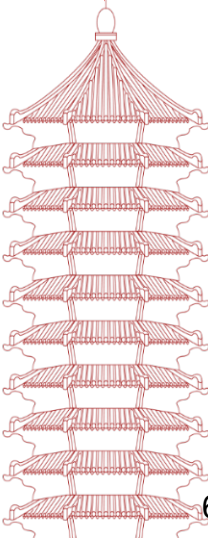
Students

- Students are not only the recipient of integrity education but also active participants



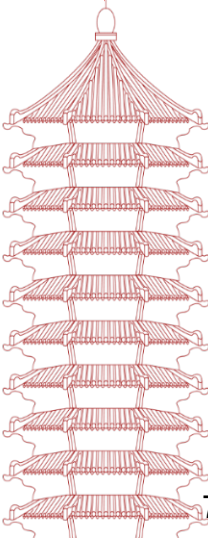
How to implement integrity education

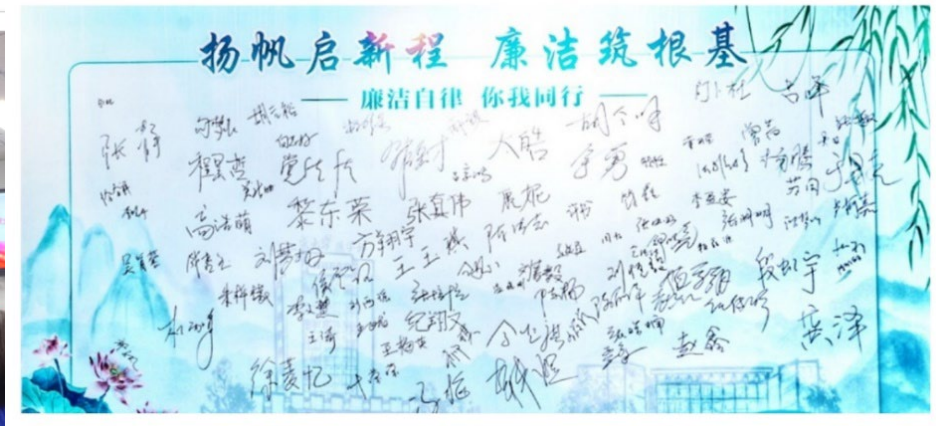
- **Establishing systems**
 - Legalization is fundamental characteristic
 - Well-developed, clear, and reasonable system is the foundation of integrity education
- **Teaching norms**
 - Adapting educational content and methods to suit diverse student personalities
 - Ensure students understand and embrace the rules
- **Strict management**
 - Tolerance without indulgence
 - Matching rights with responsibilities



Integrity education at Peking University

- **Strengthening guidance for faculty and researchers**
 - Organizing experts to summarize, refine, and theorize the elements of integrity from traditional culture
 - Integrity education into curricula, textbooks, and teaching
- **Enhancing supervision and management of staff**
 - Educating and reminding staff, especially leadership
 - Requiring regularly report on integrity and discipline
- **Variety of integrity education formats for students**
 - Integrated into the orientation for new students
 - Incorporated into award evaluations, class activities, and social practice
 - Emphasized integrity education for graduates
